

SYMONDSBURY PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of a Policy Committee Meeting held on 12 April 2011 at Symondsburry School at 7pm.

Present: Cllrs A Streatfeild, P Smith, S Holmes, C.Harp, G Butcher, B Baker and M Costello.

1. **A number of members of the public were present** wishing to give their views on the planning application for the continuance of the garden café at Down House Farm. Over the next thirty minutes the comments were listened to and noted. Most left at the end of the Public period.
2. **Apologies. None.**
3. **The minutes** of the meeting held on 8 February 2011 having been previously circulated were taken as read and were approved.
4. **Chairman's Announcements.** The chairman reviewed the Annual Parish Meeting. The contributions of the speakers were well received and aroused the interest of members of the parish. Carly Galloway spoke of the changes in the requirements of the Resilience Programme. Julia Colfox and John Dean reported on the progress of work at Manor Yard and Chris Reynolds reported progress of the Community Land Trust. The problem of signage at West Cliff is being looked into as is the land slip and road surface at Higher Morbath and the land slip at Skilling Hill.

6. **Planning.** 1/D/11/0257 Consider approval of reserved matters of Landscaping, appearance and scale at land to the rear of 108 to 114 West Bay Road. (Adjoining Parish Consultation) 1/D/11/0367 Consideration of continuance of use of garden café at Down House Farm. After consideration of all aspects of this application the parish council decided that it had no option but to object to the application.
7. **Payment.** A further invoice for the balance of the rental of Allotment Gardens had been received from DCC for the sum of £60.00. On the proposition of Cllr Smith and carried unanimously it was agreed that this amount be paid.
